MEMBER CONCERNS

Concerns were expressed about the effect of a rate increase and the longevity of the club.

Paul – Traditionally, the club has \$200,000 of revenue per year. The club is losing money during the summer, and down to \$7,000 balance. Electric bill is about \$1,900/mo, and some practice nights are not very busy and not meeting that night's expenses. We did cut some costs (eliminating \$306/mo for the Mobile Mini, streamlining race worker team). Paul also went over the pending lease renewal (as discussed in prior meetings).

Member thoughts are to increase membership as the top priority, with the Kart shops potentially taking the lead. We need to put the word out to get new members as well as enticing former members to come back. It was suggested that we should bring karts to car shows. We should have some fliers. Curtis also some business cards with the schedule. Please send any other ideas to the board.

A member observation is that Tuesday nights there are 8-10 kids, but only 3 on race day. Issues appear to be money and time commitment. A suggestion was made that having championship points at least in the winter might help (Would need to get IKF approval for competitive kid karts). It was felt going through Rich's class was well worth while and a pre-requisite.

Paul suggested that each of us promote the races and follow-up with those in

that class.

In the past, everyone had to volunteer one race per season, and they received first place points. It might be possible to get volunteer EMTs, but what we are paying seems to be very reasonable. Rich has noted that the volunteer track workers weren't as consistent or reliable. Some level of experience is required. Paul will make an announcement asking for volunteers.

Rich would like to go back to the 3 sub-configurations of the Vintage (Full, Short, 2 Straights). We would also like to have a rain date. The Competition Committee will rework the schedule accordingly.

Showdown racing just paid \$2,000 and donated wristbands.

Proposal from Paul: It is recommended that we set a policy as follows:

- Any new business can be raised by any member at or before a scheduled meeting for discussion and a "provisional vote". If the item received an approved "provisional vote", the item will then be posted with the minutes and placed on the next posted meeting for a "final vote" after which it will become effective.
- Discussion was that these would be more significant decisions, and that the board could waive this as required.
- The board approved this with the discussed clarification.

We will go to one board meeting a month.

Approve Minutes

• Prior Meeting Minutes (Oct 17, 2016). Approved by the board.

Rate Increase Discussion and Vote

- Proposal for raising race pricing. Prices will not be raised at this time.
- Note: Approximately 40 racers are needed under the current fee schedule and paid worker plan, to break even at each race (on an operating basis).

Practice Schedule Discussion

- Wednesday & Thursday practice was reinstated. It costs approximately \$135.00 per evening practice session to have open practice. In some cases there are very few participants.
- The members discussion was mixed, with some thoughts that some limited reduction might be acceptable (Perhaps alternate Wed/Thu closures). We will plan to keep the current schedule.

Awards Banquet

- Not discussed at this meeting, but status follows.
- Options were discussed to control costs, such as holding the event at the track to bring membership back. Input since suggests an event at K1 to begin building the collaboration between indoor and PKRA? Jason Altzman is taking the lead on the K1 discussions. Mark Traylor is working on special trophies.
- We still need to confirm the date.
- We still need a volunteer to chair (get sponsors / prizes, food) and a good committee to handle details

First Winter Race – Nov 13

- Pre-Registration will open Nov 8 (it has)
- Registration will be in the double conex.
- Registration is now going to be handled with volunteer workers.
- Johnny will no longer be announcing. He will be taking his equipment. Bernie will take the lead to make sure the system still works.
