Approve Minutes

 Approve Dec 9 Open Meeting Minutes and Closed Board minutes of Nov 11 and Dec 9. Approved.

Race Logistics/Procedures – Next Race – Jan 19 Winter Race #6

- Status on finding a Tech Inspector. Bernie found someone who will start Jan 19.
- Continued discussion on what do we need to do to raise the level of our race day officiating/operations.
 - Rich Bowen will be having a meeting Jan 15 to review rules with workers.
- Are we going to enforce age rules?
 - Moving down an age group within 2 cycle/4 cycle. The rule stands.
 - What are our Tag100 ages? IKF 16 or SKUSA 14?
 Deferred.
- Issue of one-off karts interfering with races of larger classes.
 We will continue to allow one-off karts even though they sometimes cause issues.
- Refunds
 - On refunds, we will subtract pit pass amount from race entry amount (e.g. \$60-\$10=\$50) if they were at the race.
- Far End Front Row Pit Spots.
 - Do we want to set different pricing/rules for pits 45-59 as they are less desirable? No, we won't change the pricing.
- Registration
 - We need to get registration and entry into Orbits correct.

In particular, the differentiation between Tag125 and Tag100, Differentiation between Tag Jr and Sr, and the two different Shifter classes. This is particularly important since Bill is not planning on being at Race #6.
