Call to order at 7:00 PM. John, Rich, David, Charlie, James, Cameron and Paul were present.

Open – John – Finance Review – Race Day Planning

- 7 members are online to begin and approximately.

Financial Review – Update – Current Balance Sheet – including Income/Expense

- \$22,266 Checking minus 9K for B-grid canopy
- Savings \$85,175
- CD \$5466.00
- Race #2 had 72 entrants. Race #1 69 entrants.
- Mid-60 to mid-70 has been average
- Membership income is up in every category compared to 2025
- Non-race income is up to over 10K
- 60 to 65 entrants are our perceived break-even point

Workday - Canopy

- B-grid is up and usable.
- A service fee was talked about being charged to members annually.
- Light shields were installed. These shields improved the brightness of the lights.
- Tires were adjusted, weeds were removed, bathroom floors were painted, structure for shade was installed over the outside registration, and more shade material was installed on A-grid
- A member online offered to volunteer and organize workday activities. Paul will be the point of contact.



Competition Committee Update - Incidents

- Transponders were not charged for the last race. A charging routine needs to be better organized.
- Protest times will have a time stamp for protests lodged.
- Stressed returning transponders more efficiently

Tech

- Random fuel tests.
- Fuel was provided to random competitors before the main event. The class was randomly chosen.
- Different methods will be used.
- A member asked about our testing tool. Tech is continuing different testing methods.
- We don't have a baseline for the Dill Petroleum product currently.

Merchandise

- The new hats have arrived. They were displayed during the races.
- T-shirts will be for sale during race #3.
- The Board described how the certificates are won in the senior classes.

Projects

- 1K owed to finish the concrete under the new B- grid canopy.
- The fence fabric is up on B-grid. The grid is fully functional.
- IT plan and complete integration of social media and website operations.
- Goal is to have complete control and management of these sites.
- We would like more people involved with Alpha management.
- Track review repair. The repairs needed are not dangerous. More information will be provided on installing a concrete runoff next to the rumble strips.
- The Board will investigate the product stabilizer that may be better than the Gorilla Snot we currently use to mitigate the dirt from moving around.



- We request that the bumps inside of turns #5, Vintage and #3.
- We will need a large enough tractor to fix our drainage near the back straight. This would require surveys, permits etc.
- A-project on electrical for removing old poles in the infield and repairing poles that need attention.
- Roof was repaired and the county approved.
- Scales roof was repaired.

Round Table

- An online member asked that communication be improved and that the Board ask the members what their needs are.
- The new prices for additional club members when renting the track will be reviewed.
- The Board explained the logic behind the driver rental fees. The new rules are designed to share rental days.
- A discussion was developed about projects and who can decide on them.
- Another member asked about rental fees and being priced at the current winter levels.
- Food trucks and menu items for workers will be revisited.
